

# FOLDED STAR ORNAMENTS

Finished size: Approximately 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

## *Materials (for each star):*

4 – 4" x 14" strips of cotton fabric.

Note: You can make nine stars from six unique fat quarters and each star will be slightly different.

*Flatter* or similar fabric starch

Thread to hang

## *Tools:*

Iron

Hand sewing needle

BEFORE SEWING AND CUTTING, PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS TO FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH THEM.

## *Instructions:*

These stars are nothing more than folded and pressed fabric. Stars can be made with a single patterned or solid fabric, but are most fun when mixing a variety of coordinating fabrics. Each of your four strips can be from a different fabric or pick two fabrics like the ones shown in the pictures.

Press all strips in half lengthwise, then press strips in quarters with raw edges inside (like making bias binding without the bias). **Figures 1 & 2.**

Your strips are now 14" long and 1" wide and four layers of fabric deep.

Using needle and heavy thread stitch a loop through the top center to hang.

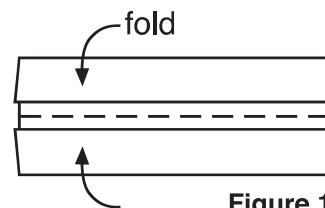

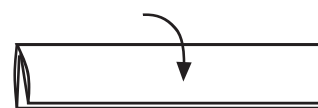
