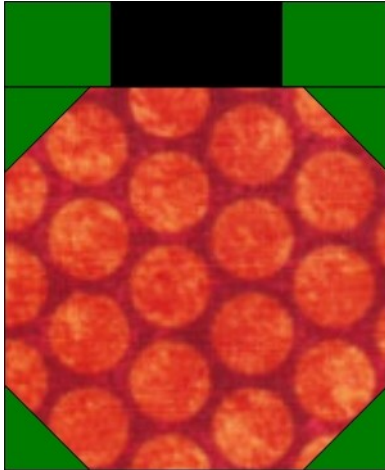


Christmas Bulb

4 ½" x 5 ½" finished block size



Fabric requirements:

1 – 5" square for center(big prints work great)

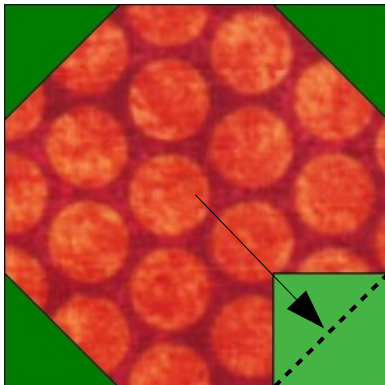
Green for tree background

2 – 1 ½ x 1 ¾ rectangles

4 - 1 ½ x 1 ½ squares

Black for hanger

1 – 1 ½ x 2 ½ rectangle



STEP 1 – Bulb

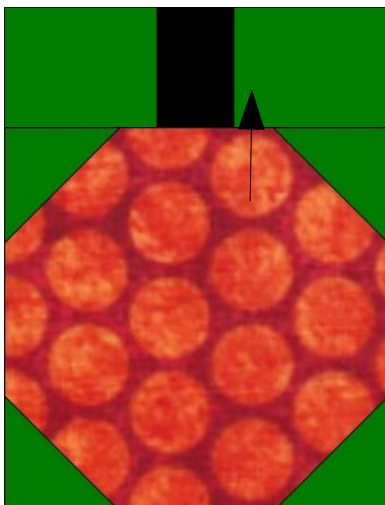
Using each of the 4 green 1 ½" squares and the 5" center colored square, sew the bulb corners as shown. Lay a 1 ½" green square and the 5" center square right sides together, RST. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Stitch on the drawn line. Press towards the smaller corner square as shown by the arrow.

No need to cut away the extra fabric behind the corner units. This block measures 5" square.



STEP 2 – Hanger unit.

Using the green 1 ½ x 1 ¾ rectangles and the black 1 ½ x 2 ½ rectangle, sew together the unit shown to the left. Press towards the black. This unit measures 1 ½ x 5.



STEP 3 – Completing the Christmas Bulb block

Sew together the units from Step 1 and Step 2 to complete your Christmas bulb block. Press the final seam towards the hanger unit as shown by the arrow. The block should now measure 5 x 6.

Give it a final pressing using Best Press or Terial Magic.
